

## Day 1: Arrival in Havana

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit a private Tobacco farm to learn about cigars rolling process from the owner and his family.
- Free time to stroll the village and visit the cigar rolling process, interact with vendors at the craft market, learn about their culture and traditions.
- Lunch included at Finca Paraíso, a local organic farm. You can interact with the local "cuentapropistas" and listen to their stories, difficulties and contributions to social projects in town.
- Horse back riding at surrounded by this beautiful landscape to enjoy the area. (optional)
- Dinner on your own.





## Day 4: Departure to Las Terrazas

- In the afternoon, you can enjoy a visit to the community circus project Angeles del Futuro. Children will offer the visitors an incredible stop at show. Interact with the artists and trainers afterwards
- Experience a wonderful dinner at a local paladar (included).



## Day 6: Havana....one more day


- Breakfast at the hotel.
