

Day 1: SUNDAY, June 24 (Arrival to Rome)

- Arrivals from overnight flight from US to Rome Fiumicino Airport.
- Meet at I Pini Family Park Roma Resort.
- Options for transfer from airport to resort (more details will be available with travel documents):
 1. Taxi from airport directly to resort
 2. Private transfer from airport directly to resort
 3. Shuttle service from airport directly to resort
- Afternoon at leisure or Travel. Your Way! OPTIONS available:
 1. Self-guided visit to Castel Sant'Angelo
 2. Guided visit to the Colosseum and Roman Forum with reserved admission.

Day 3: TUESDAY, June 26 (Siena and Tuscany)

- Walking tour of Siena with local guide showcasing the best sites, including a visit inside the Cathedral or Duomo of Siena.

- Typical Tuscan dinner served at a nearby restaurant this evening.

Day 4: WEDNESDAY, June 27 (Daytrip to Florence)

- Breakfast at resort at leisure.
- Spend the morning and early afternoon in the city of Florence exploring all this Renaissance city has to offer.
- Short morning guided walking tour of Florence to include Piazza del Duomo, Piazza della Repubblica and the Ponte Vecchio.
- Take some time to enjoy the city on your own, do a little shopping, or visit other historic monuments and museums.
- Return to resort.
- Afternoon at leisure to enjoy the resort, go for a nice country walk, or take a swim.
